Course Description : Enhance of four Chinese skills in daily and business application.

Course Objectives : This course aims to enable students to:

1. enhance listening skills through the recordings or given topics in Chinese daily life as well as business contexts.
2. enhance speaking skills including the way to express, to comment or to summarize their own thinking orally on the topics discussed.
3. enhance reading and in Chinese daily life and business contexts through the passages, news or articles.
4. enhance writing skills in summarizing and how to make a good writing.
5. comprehend reading texts and passages, and summarize into sentences or paragraphs

Teaching-Learning Activities:

1. Lecture
2. Assignments (Exercises, Attendance, and Class participation)
3. Oral presentation and Role play
4. Listening to recordings and answering questions, Speaking with given topics, Reading short passages and answering questions, Writing paragraphs from given topics

Do: Implement the plans and new processes developed.

Check: Monitor and evaluate the implemented process by testing the results against the predetermined objectives.

Act: Apply actions necessary for improvement if the results require changes.

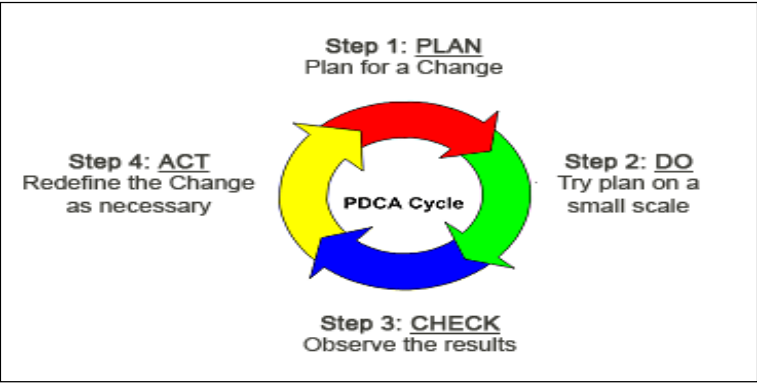


Figure 1: PDCA Cycle (<http://www.swopehealth.org>)
